The family lives in a rented house and has experienced multiple migrations in search of affordable living conditions. They initially moved from their village to Sanagaon and later settled in damaitar, lalitpur due to cheaper rents.

In terms of education, Aakriti has shown considerable progress despite starting school relatively late. She is confident in verbal tasks and has made significant strides in coloring and writing, demonstrating neatness and attention to detail. Although she takes slightly longer to complete tasks like coloring, her overall academic performance is balanced across all subjects.

Aakriti's health has significantly improved since she started school. Initially, she had a poor appetite and frequently fell ill, preferring store-bought food over homemade meals. However, her mother reported a positive change as Aakriti began enjoying homemade food and now eats well both at home and school, leading to better health and vitality.

Socially and emotionally, Aakriti is a friendly and cooperative child. She enjoys group activities, playing with friends, and actively participating in discussions. Her sense of teamwork and willingness to collaborate with others are notable strengths. She also takes interest in extracurricular activities, such as sports, dancing, crafting, and maintaining discipline.

Despite her positive development, some challenges remain. The long distance between her home and the school is a concern, especially since her mother is pregnant, making the commute more difficult. Nonetheless, Aakriti's parents ensure she attends school regularly. They are deeply satisfied with her progress in speech, behavior, and overall development, actively participating in school meetings to express their gratitude.
